A sustainable festival furniture piece designed to bring people together! The furniture is inspired by tents that are often wasted at festivals each year, and the construction principles of these. This furniture incorporates the reusable parts from those tents to minimize our festival waste.

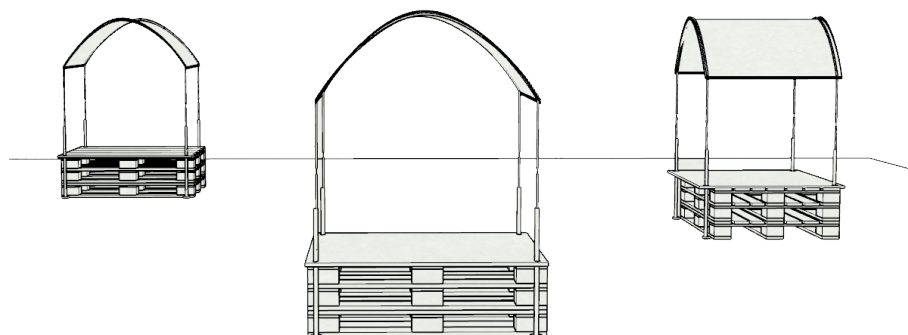


name

The furniture is called "Tents'R'Us". The use of the word "Tents" in the title indicates that these temporary houses are an essential part of the festival experience. They function as our accommodation, providing us with a place to rest and recharge between performances and activities. Without tents, the festival experience would be drastically different and less enjoyable. The R refers to the words Reuse, Reduce and Recycle – and obviously Roskilde Festival. The use of the word "Us" is for the social dimension, both meaning that we need to take responsibility for our own festival waste and the fact that this furniture invites to socialize and chill.

socializing

The design is modular which means it can be expanded. To encourage social interaction, the furniture is designed to be arranged in groups, creating a communal space for festival-goers to socialize and relax in their own unique seating arrangements.

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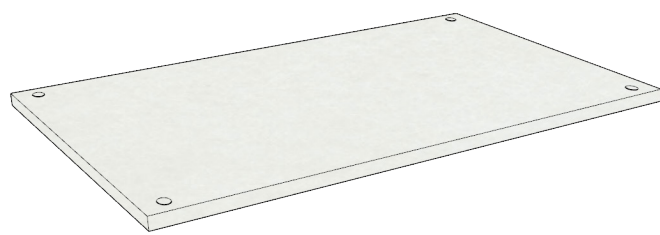
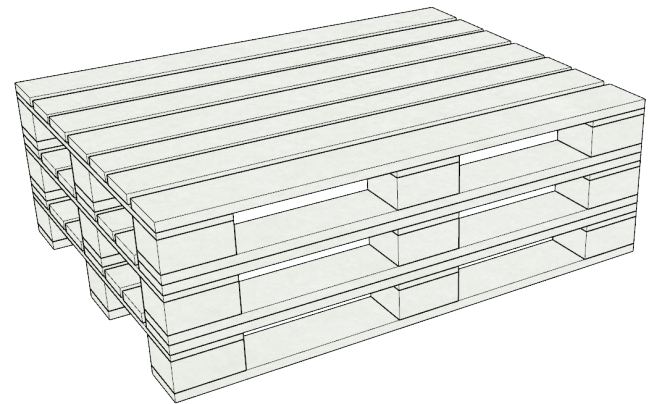
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MATERIALS

pallets

The main component is three large pallets that serve as the base. We have chosen to use pallets as so many food vendors at the festival uses pallets for transportation of materials to and from the festival. During the festival the food vendors has a need to store the pallets elsewhere and with our construction we are trying to meet and solve this need of theirs. With this solution the pallets serve a purpose before, during and after the festival. This also means, that the only thing Roskilde Festival needs to store when the festival ends, is the small flat packable materials used in the furniture.

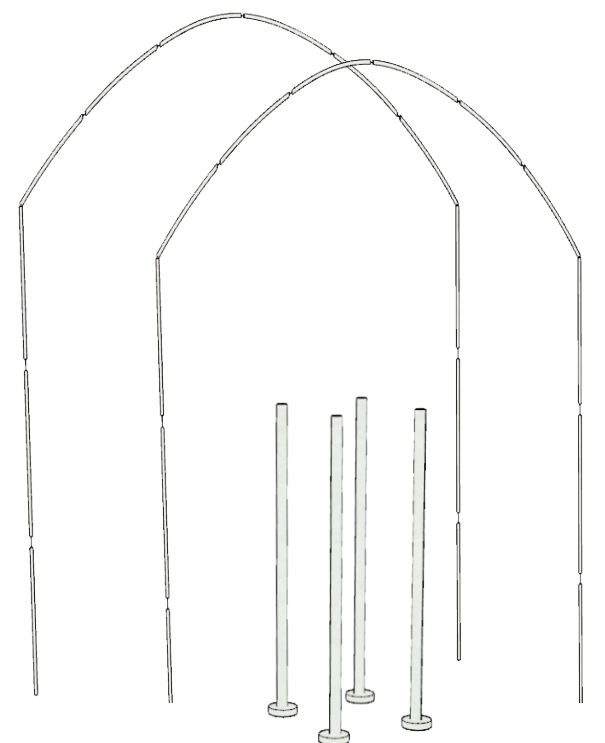
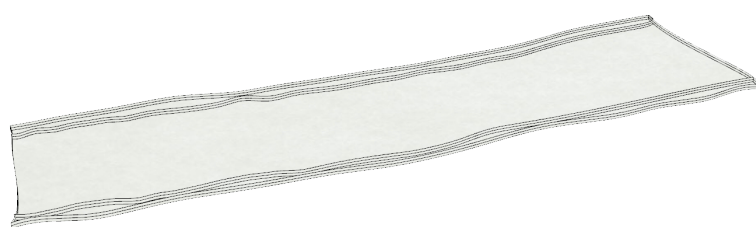


leftover cuts of plywood

On top of the three pallets, we have used a plate of plywood. This material is from Stark's leftover cuts. We have minimized the use of plywood to the bare minimum. This plate of plywood is required to make a construction without damaging the pallets and it furthermore works as a comfortable surface for seating.

recycled tent covers, tent poles and water pipes

The cover is made from the fabric of wasted tents, which is upcycled to give them a new purpose. The tent poles are from destroyed tents and are used to fasten the tent-cover. The water pipes are from plumbing firms. Lots of water pipes, that are no longer able to be used for plumbing purposes, are delivered to recycling stations. Instead of them ending up at recycling stations they can be used in this furniture serving a new purpose.



circularity

Together these materials (**all reused**) create a construction without the need of any screws or nails. This also means that the furniture can be assembled and disassembled very easily within a few minutes without the use of any tools and that the pallets are not destroyed and therefore can circulate in the EUR-pallet pant system afterwards.
