#### Things to Know

• **Thongchai Jaidee** carded the round of the day with 7-under 65 to climb the leaderboard and shares the top spot with Charles Schwab No. 2 **Miguel Angel Jimenez** entering Sunday's final round.

# Thongchai Jaidee, 69-65 - 134 (-10)

- Matched his low 18-hole score on PGA TOUR Champions (54 rounds)
  - Two previous times carding 65: R1/2021 Principal Charity Classic, R2/2021 The Ally Challenge
- This is his first time leading/co-leading entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions
  - Previous best position entering the final round: 4th (2021 The Ally Challenge), T4 (2021 U.S. Senior Open)
- 52-year-old seeks his first win on PGA TOUR Champions (19th start)
  - Best finish: T5 (2021 SAS Championship)
- A win on Sunday would be his first official victory in an individual tournament since the 2016 Open de France (DP World Tour)
  - o It would snap a winless streak of 5 years, 11 months, 9 days (or 2,170 days)
    - Note: Jaidee teamed up with Phachara Khongwatmai to win the 2019 GolfSixes Cascais (unofficial event on the DP World Tour)
- A win on Sunday would be the first victory by a player from Thailand on PGA TOUR Champions

# Miguel Angel Jimenez, 66-68 - 134 (-10)

- Charles Schwab No. 2 will play in the last group of the final round for the third time this season
  - He is 1-for-2 converting those into victories
  - This is the second consecutive year that he will play in the last group of the final round at the American Family Insurance Championship
- 58-year-old holds the lead/co-lead entering the final round for the 16<sup>th</sup> time since he joined PGA TOUR Champions in 2014.
  - He is 6-for-15 converting those into victories.
- With a win on Sunday, he would earn his third win of the season and 13<sup>th</sup> victory on PGA TOUR Champions

- Would tie Steven Alker for the most wins by any player in 2022
- Would post his most single-season wins on PGA TOUR Champions
  - Has four two-win seasons, including 2022
- Matched his low 36-hole score at the American Family Insurance Championship
  - o Previous: 2017

#### **Other Notes**

- Paul Broadhurst, Paul Goydos and 18-hole leader Steve Flesch are T3 at 9-under.
  - With a win on Sunday, Flesch would become the third multiple-time winner this season on PGA TOUR Champions, joining Steven Alker (3) and Miguel Angel Jimenez (2).
- David Branshaw, Kirk Triplett and Colin Montgomerie are T6 at 8-under.
- Seeking his third consecutive American Family Insurance Championship victory (2019, 2021), **Jerry Kelly** is T9 at 7-under with seven other players. Kelly also captured last week's Principal Charity Classic title.
  - With a win on Sunday, he would become the first player to win the same tournament three consecutive times on PGA TOUR Champions since Bernhard Langer (2014-16 Bridgestone SENIOR PLAYERS Championship).
- Tournament host **Steve Stricker** posted 3-under 69 and sits T25 at 4-under.
