Decades of strong partnerships advancing health education

Mohawk College opened the Institute for Applied Health Sciences at McMaster in 2001; opened the college's first Living Classroom at Schlegel Villages Wentworth Heights in 2019 and the Villages of Tansley Woods in 2023, training PSWs and occupational therapy assistants.

There is a need for skilled healthcare workers in Ontario.

Ontario is experiencing a critical shortage of healthcare workers and the demand for professionals in this field is expected to grow substantially.

Centre for Integrated and Advanced Medical Imaging (CIAMI)

Located at our Institute for Applied Health Sciences at McMaster University, CIAMI offers a new training model that expedites MRI technologist graduates while addressing patient wait times in a way that has never been done before in Ontario.

Centre for Healthcare Simulation and Research (CHSR)

Replicating real-world healthcare environments, CHSR improves the student experience through simulation-based training and supports research in the use of simulations on advanced manikins that provide learners with realistic and interactive healthcare scenarios in hospital-like settings.

Burlington Expansion

The first phase of the expansion aims to establish a health campus that will serve Burlington and the greater Halton region.

With Mohawk College's deep ties to local industry through established clinical

placements and research initiatives, it is uniquely positioned to meet the healthcare educational needs of the region.

The campus will aim to serve **approximately 3,000 students annually**, integrating local healthcare providers and community services to ensure students gain hands-on experiences to remain connected and responsive to evolving healthcare needs.
