

# WCTC Board to select next president in the near future

PEWAUKEE — After a comprehensive national search, the Waukesha County Technical College District Board of Trustees has selected two finalists in its presidential search.

Those finalists, Richard Barnhouse and Laurie Borowicz, had interviews Monday and the district board is planning “meet the candidate” events with virtual options to maximize broad participation and public health interests.

Don Stevens and Associates, a firm assisting with the search, said the WCTC board’s meetings with the candidates went well. “Don Stevens and Associates Executive Search has been pleased to work with the WCTC District Board and stakeholders in the search for the college’s next president,” the firm said, in a statement. “On Oct. 5, the board spent very productive time with two top candidates, Richard Barnhouse, Ph.D. and Laurie Borowicz, Ed.D., from a talented pool of almost sixty applicants. We look forward to the Board’s selection of a new president in the near future.”

The college plans to hire for the presidential position later in fall. The new president will follow Kaylen Betzig, who has led WCTC since 2014. Betzig will officially retire at the end of December.
