

Three spots to open soon on WCTC District Board

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WAUKESHA — The board that governs Waukesha County Technical College will have three openings this summer for new directors and applicants are currently being sought, said Waukesha County Board Chairman Paul Decker.

Written applications are due by 4 p.m. on Feb. 26. District Board applications and application guidelines can be found at <https://bit.ly/2lc8pzS>. The board will have positions open for:

- An employee member who is paid for work.

- An employee member who is paid for services and possess the power to hire, transfer, suspend, layoff, recall, promote, discharge, assign, reward or discipline other employees.

- An additional member who lives within the technical college district.

The WCTC District Board Appointment Committee will meet at 1:30 p.m. on March 21 to interview applicants and select the new members, said Caroline Tindall, district board executive assistant.

Applicants must be present at the

meeting for interviews in the Waukesha County Administration Center, Room AC130, 515 W. Moreland Blvd., said Decker.

Each position is a three-year term that begins July 1 and expires June 30, 2022. The district board has nine members.

Applicants must submit notarized applications along with two references supporting their appointments. The forms must be submitted to Decker's office in Room AC130.

The Appointment Committee is made up of county executives from Dodge, Jefferson, Racine and Waukesha counties. Those counties are in WCTC's service area, said Tindall.

Board members are expected to attend regular board meetings, which are open to the public, on the second Tuesday of each month. The fourth Tuesday of each month is reserved for special meetings, as needed, according to the WCTC website.

Board members receive no compensation for their services but are reimbursed for expenses, such as mileage, said Tindall.
