



Please note that the total dollars raised to date from these new areas accounts for **33%** of what has been raised so far. In addition, last year at this time we had Jeffrey Epstein's \$100,000 gift in, which we haven't gotten yet. (Is this a Judy follow-up call for this year's gift?)

We are now emphasizing follow-up with every AA. Last week we sent each AA sample follow-up letters with their weekly report. Every area received the number of follow-up VP packets they requested from us. Earlier this week we printed follow-up letters for Lane Bryant and sent them over for signature. Next week, we'll be doing VSS' letters.

FYI: Information Technologies learned that a vendor who was asked to contribute \$50,000 in fact pledged \$5000. When the head of the area learned of this when he reviewed his weekly report he called the vendor. Subsequently we were informed that this company would be increasing their gift.

We are five weeks away from the 9<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Gala. Following is a Limited Campaign update as of today:

- # of repeat donors = 86
- # of \$25,000 gifts = 8
- # of \$25,000 gifts last year at this time = 15
