MOMENTS OF IMPACT

Every gift tells a story of hope, healing, and the power of community. Through donor generosity, the Carilion Clinic Foundation provides resources that transform care for patients and families, support our staff, and advance programs that make a lasting difference.

SUPPORTING TRANSPLANT PATIENTS

Steve Morgan, MD, Carilion senior vice president and chief medical information officer, established the **Ellen Crawford Morgan Transplant Patient Care Endowment** in memory of his late wife, who passed away from kidney disease in 2024. The endowment will support the related social and medical needs of patients undergoing kidney transplants at Carilion when our program begins in 2026.



FASTER DIAGNOSES, BRIGHTER FUTURES

With a generous gift from Stewart and Mary Lou Bruce and other donors, Carilion Children’s Neurology Clinic will add a second state-of-the-art electroencephalography (EEG) room to reduce wait times and improve diagnoses of suspected brain disorders in children. In addition to upgraded imaging technology, the EEG room will include full-body video monitoring, further improving diagnoses and helping guide treatment decisions.

HONORING A LEGACY OF CARE

Dawn Long established the **Dr. Bruce Long Patient Care Endowment Fund** in memory of her husband, a Carilion surgical oncologist and physician advisor who worked to streamline care for complex patients. The fund helps cancer patients under Carilion’s care access needed medical services, equipment, and support.



CREATING SPACES THAT HEAL

Our newly opened Cardiovascular Institute (CVI) at Carilion Roanoke Memorial Hospital features the work of local artists thanks to the generosity of donors, who came together at a unique preview and sponsorship event, raising \$179,000 toward 22 works of art that reflect the natural beauty and culture of our region.

THE ART OF HEALING

PATIENT CARE EXTENDS
BEYOND MEDICINE

The **Dr. Robert L. A. Keeley Healing Arts Program**, founded in 2012 with gifts in honor of the beloved thoracic surgeon, uses visual, performing, and literary arts to create restorative, calming environments for patients, staff, and our communities.

The positive influence of creative arts experiences on emotional and physical well-being is widely understood. Now, a growing body of research also shows they improve health outcomes.

“Participating in art provides a means of self-expression, improves neuroplasticity, and reduces stress and anxiety, helping people build low-cost, low-risk habits that lead to better wellness,” says Lisa Linger, Healing Arts program manager.

Through rotating art exhibits like an annual employee art show, creative workshops, and performances by local artists and writers, the program brings vibrancy and connection to Carilion’s spaces, complementing donor-funded art installations such as those in Carilion Roanoke Memorial Hospital’s new Crystal Spring Tower.

Artists-in-residence further deepen the program’s impact by engaging patients in shared creative experiences such as music, poetry, painting, and other visual arts. The artists’ work extends into the community through offerings at Melrose Plaza, a community resource center in Northwest Roanoke, which opened in 2025, and Carilion’s Morningside Urban Farm in Southeast Roanoke.

Devoted arts supporters, the Tielkings, through a gift to the Carilion Clinic Foundation, helped expand Carilion’s Dr. Robert L. A. Keeley Healing Arts Program in 2012 to include artists-in-residence.

Through their philanthropy, they continue to provide vital support for artists while bringing healing and humanity to Carilion spaces and communities.



HELPING STARTS AT HOME

EMPLOYEES' GENEROSITY HELPS PATIENTS AND EACH OTHER

When Megan and Mac Foster found out they were expecting, they were ecstatic. But joy soon turned to sorrow when their daughter, Poppy, arrived stillborn.

Stillbirths are rare, affecting less than 1% of all pregnancies in the U.S. Megan, a nursing unit director at Carilion Roanoke Memorial Hospital, learned a genetic blood-clotting disorder contributed to their loss.

To help other families honor their stillborn child, the Fosters raised more than \$7,000 toward the purchase of a Caring Cradle, the latest generation cooling bassinet that allows grieving parents to spend more time with their baby.

In 2025, it made a difference for 48 families grieving the loss of their child.

Such selfless acts of compassion are a hallmark of Carilion employees, who also stock clothes closets for needy patients, fund hotel stays for out-of-town patient families, and give generously each year to help colleagues weather unexpected hardships.

The **Kay Yow Foundation** awarded a \$25,000 grant to support transportation and lodging for Carilion mammogram patients in need, as Carilion employees touched by breast cancer were honored during a center-court ceremony.

SPIRIT HALLOWEEN MAKES HOSPITALS LESS SCARY

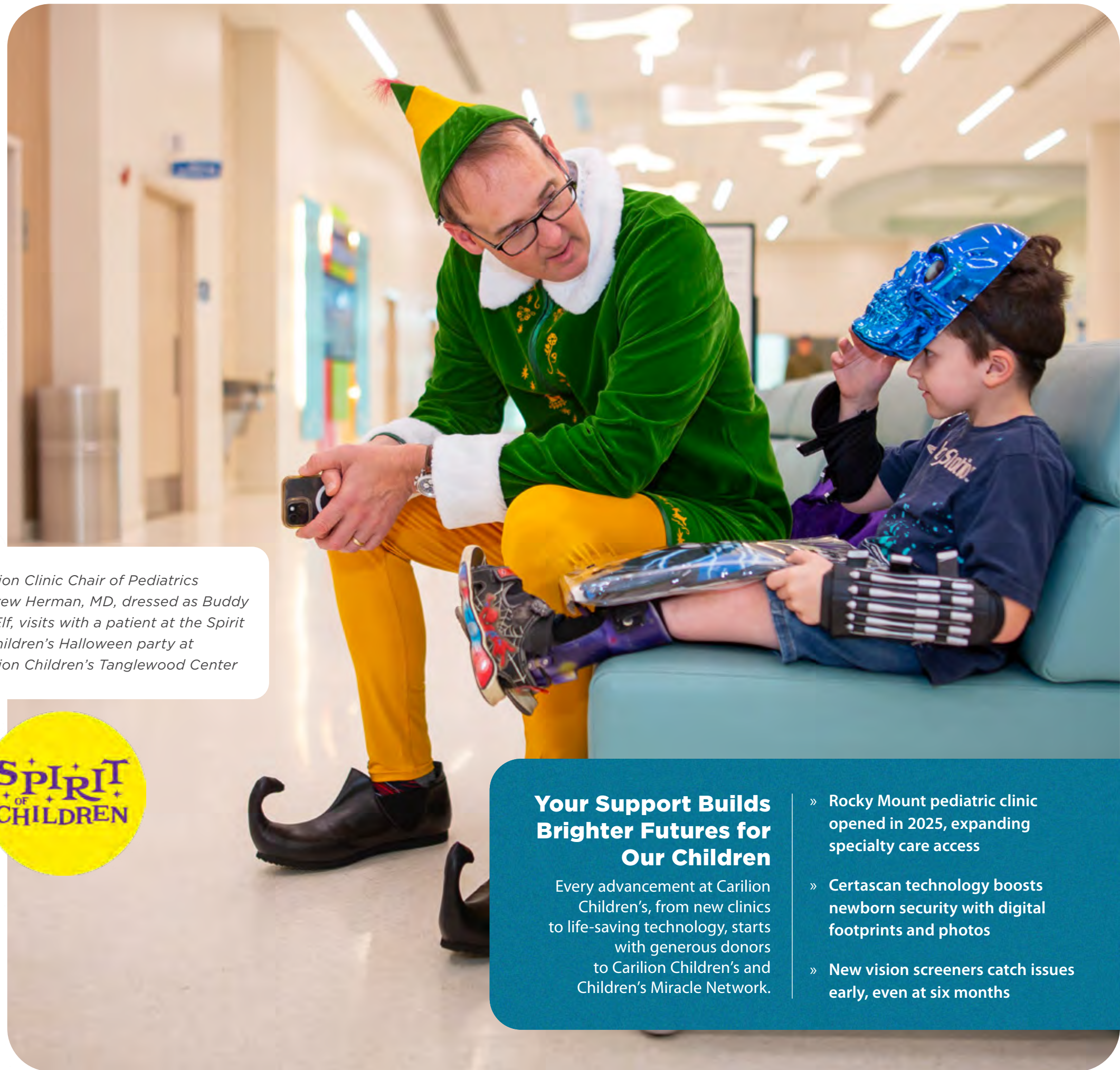
Carilion partnered with Spirit Halloween's philanthropic arm, Spirit of Children, to make hospitals less scary for kids. Customers of the national costume retailer in Southwest Virginia donated more than \$46,000 to support Carilion Children's Child Life program, which used the funding to place Xbox video gaming systems in every inpatient room at Carilion Children's.

"Being in the hospital, especially as a young child or teen, can be very challenging," says Sarah Kress, child life specialist at Carilion Children's. "One of the best ways we can support them is by normalizing the environment. Activities like video games bring fun, joy, and connection in an intimidating environment, helping us improve the patient and family experience."

In addition to collecting donations, Spirit Halloween also supports Carilion Children's Child Life program by throwing a Halloween party where kids can pick out costumes and enjoy crafts.

LEADERSHIP GIFT EXPANDS VISION FOR

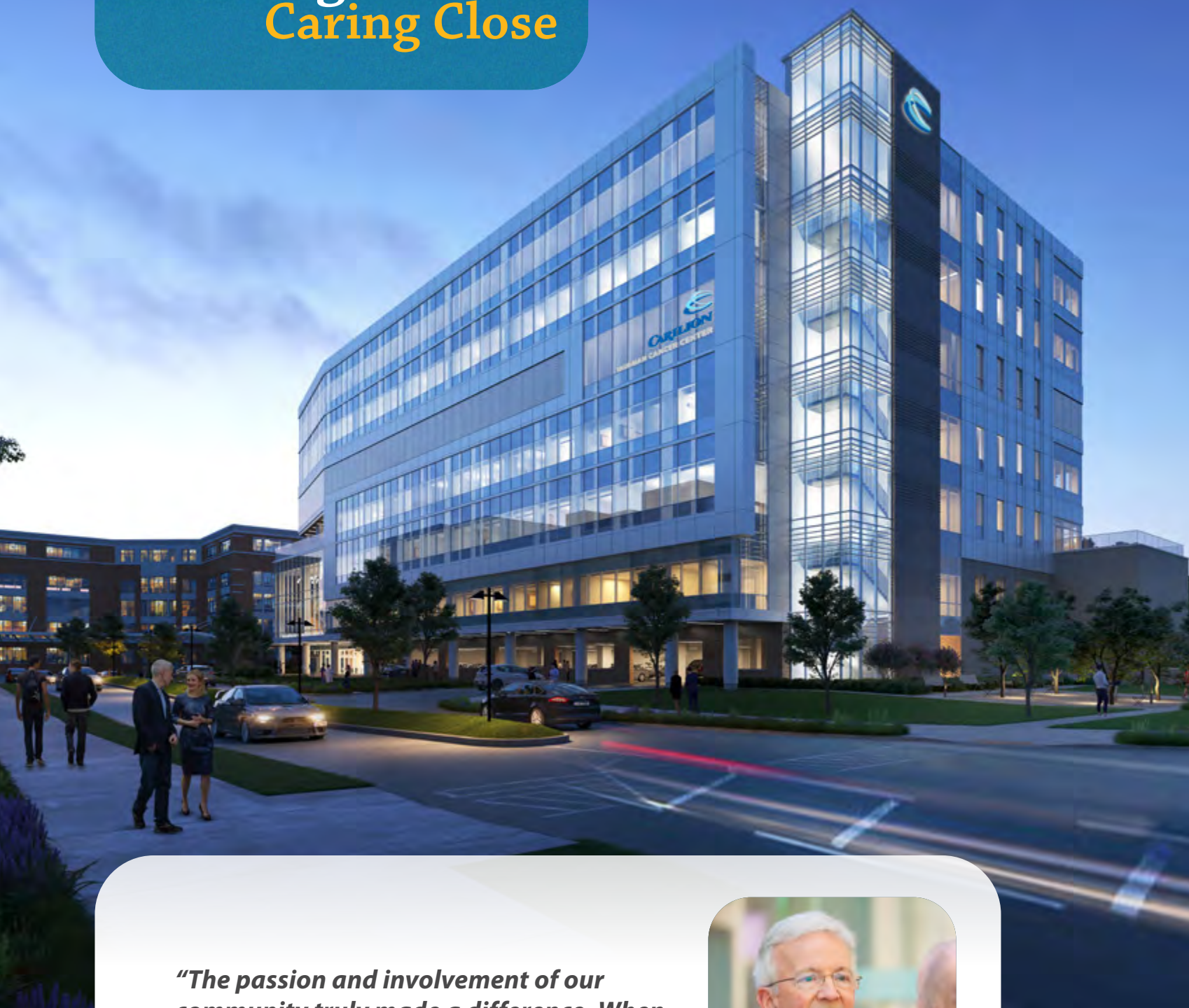

COMMUNITY SUPPORT

BRINGS THE LATEST CANCER CARE CLOSER TO HOME

Through public displays of support and creative fundraisers, more than 6,000 individuals and organizations have played a vital role in making the Carilion Taubman Cancer Center a reality.

Among the most prominent champions have been the center's general contractors, Robins & Morton Branch Builds, whose Building a Cure campaign began at Carilion and over the past two years raised more than \$108,000 through employee talent shows.

And, in a bold display of public support for cancer survivors, building partners EC Pace and Carter Machinery supplied a pink excavator and dump truck for the construction kickoff. The equipment remained on site as work continued.

Support of our new cancer center extended beyond the construction site:

- » More than 20 Lions Clubs across western Virginia and Lions Club International raised \$180,000 for a children's multipurpose room.
- » Virginia Tech student Conner Price, who lost his father to leukemia in 2017, hosted the Jason Price All-In for Cancer poker tournament in his honor, raising \$4,417 to support oncology staff education and programs.
- » Bank of Botetourt donated a Steinway Spirio player piano for the lobby to lend to the center's environment of comfort and healing.

KENT GREENAWALT DRIVES EXPONENTIAL IMPACT

Having witnessed the impact of cancer on his own family, Foot Levelers, Inc. CEO and Carilion Clinic community partner Kent Greenawalt issued a \$2 million matching challenge for Carilion's *Reaching Far, Caring Close* campaign. He viewed the challenge as a way to encourage others to improve patients' chances, saying, "Sometimes you can't fix cancer, but you can load the deck so the odds are in your favor. That's why this is important." Within two days, his leadership and passion inspired others to accept the challenge, generating more than \$4 million in new and increased support for the Carilion Taubman Cancer Center.



LIFE RING FOUNDATION ADVANCES PEDIATRIC CANCER CARE

The Life Ring Foundation made pediatric cancer a focus after co-founders Kelly and Jessica Woolwine's daughter, Charlotte, was diagnosed in 2018 at age 3 with a rare liver cancer. The experience inspired the Foundation's Fighting Kids' Cancer initiative, which seeks to improve pediatric hematology and oncology care in Southwest Virginia.

The Life Ring Foundation's \$4 million pledge and program partnership with Carilion Clinic is helping to advance our vision to enhance specialized, compassionate care close to home for children and families in the region.

HELP US BRING PROTON THERAPY HOME

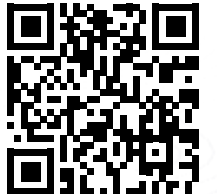
Carilion Clinic is launching the next phase of cancer care at the Carilion Taubman Cancer Center with a bold goal—to raise \$50 million to bring revolutionary proton therapy to Southwest Virginia and build the specialized wing to house it.

Thanks to the extraordinary generosity of former U.S. Ambassador Nicholas F. Taubman and Eugenia L. Taubman, whose \$17.5 million leadership gift set this effort in motion, this vision is becoming a reality. Their commitment has inspired others to step forward in support, building strong momentum toward the goal.

Proton therapy is a highly precise form of radiation that targets tumors while minimizing damage to surrounding healthy tissue and is especially helpful for children whose growing bodies are more sensitive to radiation.

By bringing proton therapy to Roanoke, we will keep families closer to home, and become a destination cancer center for patients across Virginia and the surrounding states.
