Air Canada's new Airbus A321XLR will serve key routes across the Atlantic from both Montréal and Toronto, while connecting select North American transcontinental markets. The A321XLR is the airline's newest addition in its fleet renewal program, bringing a wide-body experience to a single-aisle aircraft for the first time.

The A321XLR features a quiet, more comfortable cabin designed for calm, comfort and improved connection. This aircraft introduces our new, Glowing Hearted design standard and we are proud to introduce our Air Canada Signature Class to a single-aisle aircraft, with 14 lie-flat seats.

- A design inspired by Canada's natural landscape to create a calm and restorative journey, with every element rooted in craftsmanship and selected for timelessness and durability.
- The entrance ceiling features a backlit canopy of maple leaves for an unmistakably Canadian welcome for every customer as they board.
- Wood grain details, inspired by Canada's forests, are woven throughout the cabin, and the grey-and-white palette is warmed by stone and bronze metal accents.
- An Air Canada Signature red accent appears in seat stitching and bespoke fabrics including a unique gradient textile that adds a softer, more tactile surface.

- Lie-flat seats with a sliding privacy panel that offers flexibility for privacy or sociability, featuring durable, leather-grain finishes and bespoke fabric with signature red stitching.
- A dedicated, leather-wrapped night table with a discrete information touchscreen and a wireless device charging tray.
- A 19-inch 4K OLED in-flight entertainment screen with Bluetooth audio and accent lighting, offering cinematic quality entertainment for every customer.
- AC power outlet and multiple USB-C charging ports at each seat

Economy Class

- All new, ergonomic seating designed to maximize personal space and comfort, featuring a custom-designed textile for a modern and warm aesthetic.
- 13-inch 4K OLED in-flight entertainment screens with high-powered USB-C, Bluetooth audio and accent lighting, offering cinematic quality entertainment for every customer.
- 36 Preferred+ seats offer extra legroom.
- Bi-fold table with a built-in tablet holder, Smart space efficiency: mid-seatback multi-purpose storage for personal items and devices.
- Easy stowage: Large overhead bins and dedicated storage in the lower seatback pocket.

- The cabin design approach reflects a deliberate investment in timeless quality, balancing refined aesthetics with the durability required for use across a global network.
- Materials were chosen for their long-term performance, from durable leather-grain surfaces to powder-coated metal finishes on high-touch areas.
