

# Boeing 787-10 Dreamliner

The Boeing 787-10 Dreamliner is the new flagship of Air Canada's long-haul fleet. The newest and largest aircraft in the 787 family, it will serve key global routes from Air Canada's primary hubs starting in 2026. This aircraft represents a new level of passenger comfort and is a key pillar of Air Canada's largest-ever fleet renewal program.

The 787-10 Dreamliner showcases Air Canada's new Glowing Hearted design standard, featuring a completely reimagined cabin inspired by Canada's natural beauty that delivers a distinctly Canadian experience rooted in comfort, care and connection. It also marks the debut of the Air Canada Signature Plus suite, setting a new benchmark for premium travel in North America.

## A warm, refined Canadian welcome

- Design inspired by Canada's natural landscape to create a calm and restorative journey, with every element rooted in craftsmanship and selected for timelessness and durability.
- Business class entrance monument inspired by water patterns found in nature introduces a calm, organic sense of flow, anchored with a bronze Air Canada rondelle - a metal chosen for its elegance, warmth and enduring quality.
- Wood grain details, inspired by Canada's forests, are woven throughout the cabin, and the grey-and-white palette is warmed by stone and bronze metal accents.
- Signature red appears in seat stitching and bespoke fabrics, including a unique gradient textile that adds a softer, more tactile surface.
- A complementary dresscover fabric pairing designed to work together across Air Canada Signature Class and Premium Economy, sharing a common texture and palette, while varying colour balance to support both consistency and differentiation across applications.



## Air Canada Signature Class (42 seats)

### Air Canada Signature Plus Suites (4 seats):

- Large (two-metre) lie-flat beds, higher walls for additional privacy and personal space.
- A 27-inch 4K OLED in-flight entertainment screen with Bluetooth audio.
- A quartzite stone table and a guest seat for visits while at cruising altitude.
- Two centre suites with a fully retractable sliding privacy panel, creating an open social space for up to four (for use at cruise only).
- Seats with multiple high-powered USB-C and AC outlets.

### Air Canada Signature Class Seats (38 seats):

- Lie-flat seats in a 1x2x1 configuration, featuring durable, leather-grain finishes and bespoke fabric with signature red stitching.
- A sliding privacy panel for centre seats allows both sociability and privacy.
- A 19-inch 4K OLED in-flight entertainment screen with Bluetooth audio.
- Seats with multiple high-powered USB-C and AC outlets.

## Premium Economy

- Extended privacy wings for added privacy and comfort.
- A 16-inch 4K OLED in-flight entertainment screen with Bluetooth audio and accent lighting.
- Seats with USB-C power outlets and AC power outlet.
- Additional storage options, including mid-seat multi-purpose storage and bottle holders.

## Economy Class

- A 13-inch 4K OLED in-flight entertainment screen with high-powered USB-C, Bluetooth audio and accent lighting.
- Preferred+ seats offering added pitch.
- Enhanced storage in lower seatback pocket.

## Commitment to quality

- The cabin design approach reflects a deliberate investment in timeless quality, balancing refined aesthetics with the durability required for use across a global network.
- Materials were chosen for their long-term performance, from durable leather-grain surfaces to powder-coated metal finishes on high-touch areas.
- The focus on craftsmanship and enduring quality ensures the distinctly Canadian design language will remain consistent and beautiful for years to come.
- The new cabin design is inspired by Canada, creating a thoroughly modern space that evokes a sense of calm.
